If the physician prescribes or the member requests a covered brand name prescription drug when a generic prescription drug equivalent is available, the member will pay the difference in cost between the brand name prescription drug and the generic prescription drug equivalent plus the applicable cost-sharing. The cost difference between the generic and brand does not count toward the Out of Pocket Maximum.

Network and Non-network Providers

We cover the cost of services based on whether doctors are "in-network" or "out-of-network". We want to help you understand how much Aetna pays for your out-of-network care. At the same time, we want to make it clear how much more you will need to pay for this "out-of-network" care.

You may choose a provider (doctor or hospital) in our network. You may choose to visit an out-of-network provider. If you choose a provider who is out-of-network, your Aetna health plan will not pay any of that provider's bill. You will pay a lot more money out of your own pocket if you choose to use an out-of-network doctor or hospital.

You can avoid these extra costs by getting your care from Aetna's broad network of health care providers. Go to www.aetna.com and click on "Find a Doctor" on the left side of the page. If you are already a member, sign on to your Aetna member site.

This applies when you choose to get care out-of-network. When you have no choice (for example: emergency room visit after a car accident, or for other emergency services), we will pay the bill as if you got care in the network. You pay cost sharing and deductibles for your in-network level of benefits. Contact Aetna if your provider asks you to pay more. You are not responsible for any outstanding balance billed by your providers for emergency services beyond your cost sharing and deductibles.

What's Not Covered

This plan does not cover all health care expenses and includes exclusions and limitations. Members should refer to their plan documents to determine which health care services are covered and to what extent. The following is a partial list of services and supplies that are generally not covered. However, your plan documents may contain exceptions to this list based on state mandates or the plan design purchased.

- All medical or hospital services not specifically covered in or which are limited or excluded in the plan documents
- Charges related to any eye surgery mainly to correct refractive errors
- Cosmetic surgery, including breast reduction
- Custodial care
- Adult dental care and x-rays
- Donor egg retrieval
- Experimental and investigational procedures
- Immunizations for travel or work
- Infertility services, including, but not limited to, artificial insemination and advanced reproductive technologies such as IVF, ZIFT, GIFT, ICSI and other related services, unless specifically listed as covered in your plan documents
- Non-medically necessary services or supplies
- Orthotics except as specified in the plan
- Over-the-counter medications and supplies
- Reversal of sterilization
- Services for the treatment of sexual dysfunction or inadequacies, including therapy, supplies, counseling and prescription drugs
- Special duty nursing
- Weight reduction programs, or dietary supplements

Your pharmacy benefit is generally limited to the drugs listed on the formulary. The medications listed on the formulary are subject to change in accordance with applicable state law. For information regarding how medications are reviewed and selected for the formulary, formulary information, and information about other pharmacy programs such as precertification and step therapy, please refer to our website at www.aetna.com, or the Aetna Medication Formulary Guide. Aetna receives rebates from drug manufacturers that may be taken into account in determining Aetna's Preferred Drug List. Rebates may not reduce the amount a member pays the pharmacy for covered prescriptions. In addition, in circumstances where your prescription plan uses copayments or coinsurance calculated on a percentage basis or a deductible, use of formulary drugs may not necessarily result in lower costs for the member. Members should consult with their treating physicians regarding questions about specific medications. Refer to your plan documents or contact Member Services for information regarding the terms and limitations of coverage.
