



Rx Spectrum pharmacy network

With the Rx Spectrum pharmacy network, Blue Shield of California members can save on prescriptions at any **Level A pharmacy**.

The Rx Spectrum network is part of Blue Shield's pharmacy network and offers two options for filling prescriptions:

Level A pharmacies, also known as preferred pharmacies, offer lower copays than Level B pharmacies. Preferred pharmacies include:

- CVS Pharmacy®
- CVS Pharmacy in Target stores
- Costco
- Safeway
- Sav-On
- Vons/Pavilions

Level B pharmacies include all other pharmacies in the network. You have the same selection of covered medications at both preferred pharmacies and Level B pharmacies. However, if you use Level B pharmacies, your copays will be higher than the copays at Level A pharmacies. (See your plan's Summary of Benefits to confirm prescription copays.)

By filling your prescriptions at a **preferred pharmacy**, you can save on your out-of-pocket costs.

New 90-day retail pharmacy option

If you take maintenance medications for chronic conditions such as diabetes, you now have an alternative to 90-day mail order prescriptions. With Rx Spectrum, you can fill 90-day prescriptions at most preferred pharmacies for the same copay savings.

How do I find a preferred pharmacy?

To find preferred pharmacies near you:

1. Visit blueshieldca.com/pharmacy and select *Pharmacy networks*
2. Scroll down and select *Find an Rx Spectrum pharmacy*, and then select *Continue* to go to the Pharmacy Locator.
3. Check the *Preferred pharmacy* box.
4. Contact the preferred pharmacy of your choice to transfer prescriptions from your current pharmacy.
