Choose a primary care physician (PCP) contracted with the CommunityCare tailored network to coordinate their care.

- Their PCP can refer to any specialist in the CommunityCare Network.
- Care doesn't need to stay within the PCP's participating provider group (PPG).



Seek care at any urgent care facility in the CommunityCare Network – even those outside their PPG.



Visit MinuteClinics (available at some CVS locations) for convenient care for common illnesses, wellness screenings, vaccinations, and more.



Use Teladoc telehealth services by phone, mobile app or Web 24/7 for a \$0 copayment. Teladoc providers can treat many non-emergency common illnesses, such as sinus problems, upper respiratory infections, allergies, bronchitis, and pinkeye.

3 Further narrow your search by Provider Name/ID/License Number or by Plan/Network.

4 Select type of provider (doctor, hospital, medical group, etc.) to get your results.

5 Finally, you can click on *Print Plan Providers* to print your search results.

6 You may also select *Export Results* to obtain a spreadsheet listing of providers by medical group.
