Important Questions	Answers	Why This Matters:
What is the overall deductible?	\$750 per individual / \$1,500 per family for participating providers; \$1,500 per individual / \$3,000 per family for non-participating providers.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from providers up to the deductible amount before this plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the plan each family member must meet their own individual deductible until the total amount of deductible expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family deductible.
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?	Yes. Preventive care and services listed in your complete terms of coverage.	This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive services without cost-sharing and before you meet your deductible. See a list of covered preventive services at healthcare.gov/coverage/preventive-care-benefits .
Are there other deductibles for specific services?	Yes. Prescription drugs -- \$250 per individual / \$500 per family. There are no other specific deductibles.	You must pay all of the costs for these services up to the specific deductible amount before this plan begins to pay for these services.
What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan?	\$7,800 per individual / \$15,600 per family for participating providers; \$13,850 per individual / \$27,700 per family for non-participating providers.	The out-of-pocket limit is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this plan, they have to meet their own out-of-pocket limits until the overall family out-of-pocket limit has been met.
What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit?	Copayments for certain services, premiums, balance-billing charges, and health care this plan doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the out-of-pocket limit.
Will you pay less if you use a network provider?	Yes. See blueshieldca.com/fad or call 1-888-319-5999 for a list of network providers.	This plan uses a provider network. You will pay less if you use a provider in the plan's network. You will pay the most if you use an out-of-network provider, and you might receive a bill from a provider for the difference between the provider's charge and what your plan pays (balance billing). Be aware, your network provider might use an out-of-network provider for some services (such as lab work). Check with your provider before you get services.
Do you need a referral to see a specialist?	No.	You can see the specialist you choose without a referral.

Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? **Yes**

If you don't have Minimum Essential Coverage for a month, you'll have to make a payment when you file your tax return unless you qualify for an exemption from the requirement that you have health coverage for that month.

Does this plan meet the Minimum Value Standards? **Yes**

If your plan doesn't meet the Minimum Value Standards, you may be eligible for a premium tax credit to help you pay for a plan through the Marketplace.

About these Coverage Examples:



This is not a cost estimator. Treatments shown are just examples of how this plan might cover medical care. Your actual costs will be different depending on the actual care you receive, the prices your providers charge, and many other factors. Focus on the cost sharing amounts (deductibles, copayments and coinsurance) and excluded services under the plan. Use this information to compare the portion of costs you might pay under different health plans. Please note these coverage examples are based on self-only coverage.

Peg is Having a Baby
(9 months of participating pre-natal care and a hospital delivery)

- The plan's overall deductible \$750
- Specialist copayment \$50
- Hospital (facility) coinsurance 20%
- Other copayment \$30

This **EXAMPLE** event includes services like:

- Specialist office visits (*prenatal care*)
- Childbirth/Delivery Professional Services
- Childbirth/Delivery Facility Services
- Diagnostic tests (*ultrasounds and blood work*)
- Specialist visit (*anesthesia*)

Total Example Cost \$12,800

In this example, Peg would pay:

Managing Joe's Type 2 Diabetes
(a year of routine participating care of a well-controlled condition)

- The plan's overall deductible \$750
- Specialist copayment \$50
- Hospital (facility) coinsurance 20%
- Other copayment \$30

This **EXAMPLE** event includes services like:

- Primary care physician office visits (*including disease education*)
- Diagnostic tests (*blood work*)
- Prescription drugs
- Durable medical equipment (*glucose meter*)

Total Example Cost \$7,400

In this example, Joe would pay:

The total Joe would pay is	\$3,540

Mia's Simple Fracture
(participating emergency room visit and follow up care)

- The plan's overall deductible \$750
- Specialist copayment \$50
- Hospital (facility) coinsurance 20%
- Other copayment \$50

This **EXAMPLE** event includes services like:

- Emergency room care (*including medical supplies*)
- Diagnostic test (*x-ray*)
- Durable medical equipment (*crutches*)
- Rehabilitation services (*physical therapy*)

Total Example Cost \$1,900

In this example, Mia would pay:

The total Mia would pay is	\$1,220
